We go to work early in the morning. It is still dark when we go to the bakery.

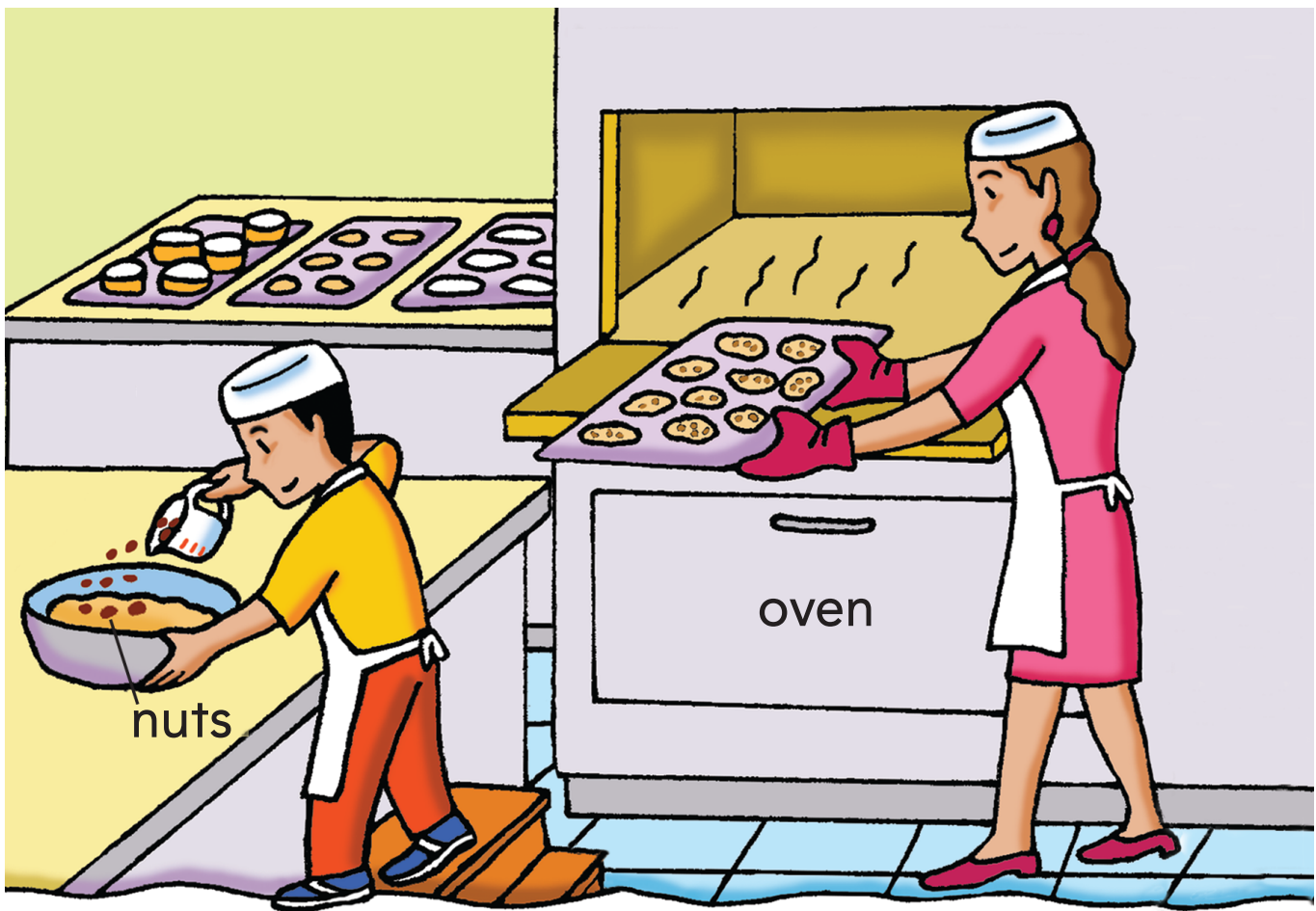

into the store.

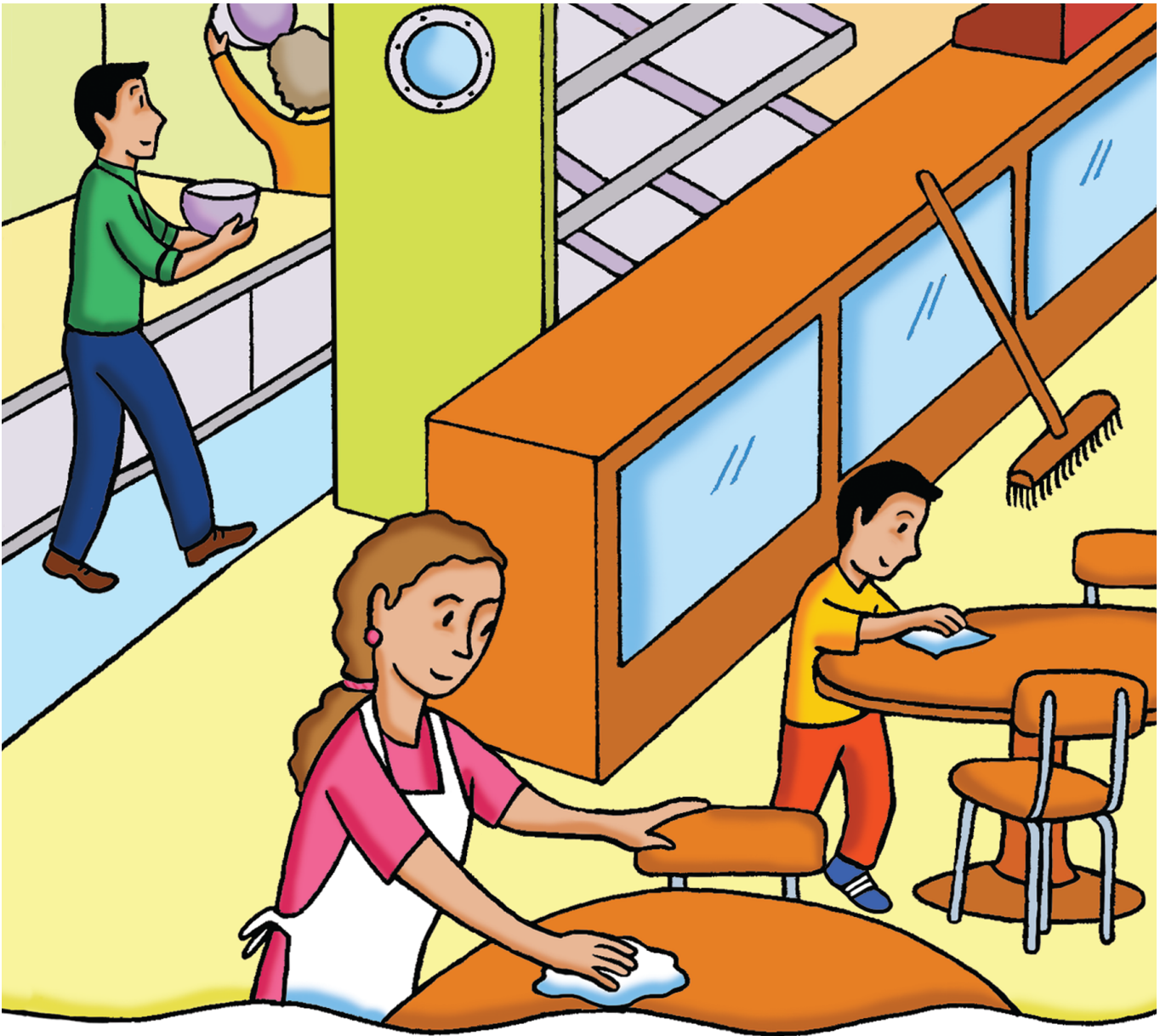


Soon people come to our store.

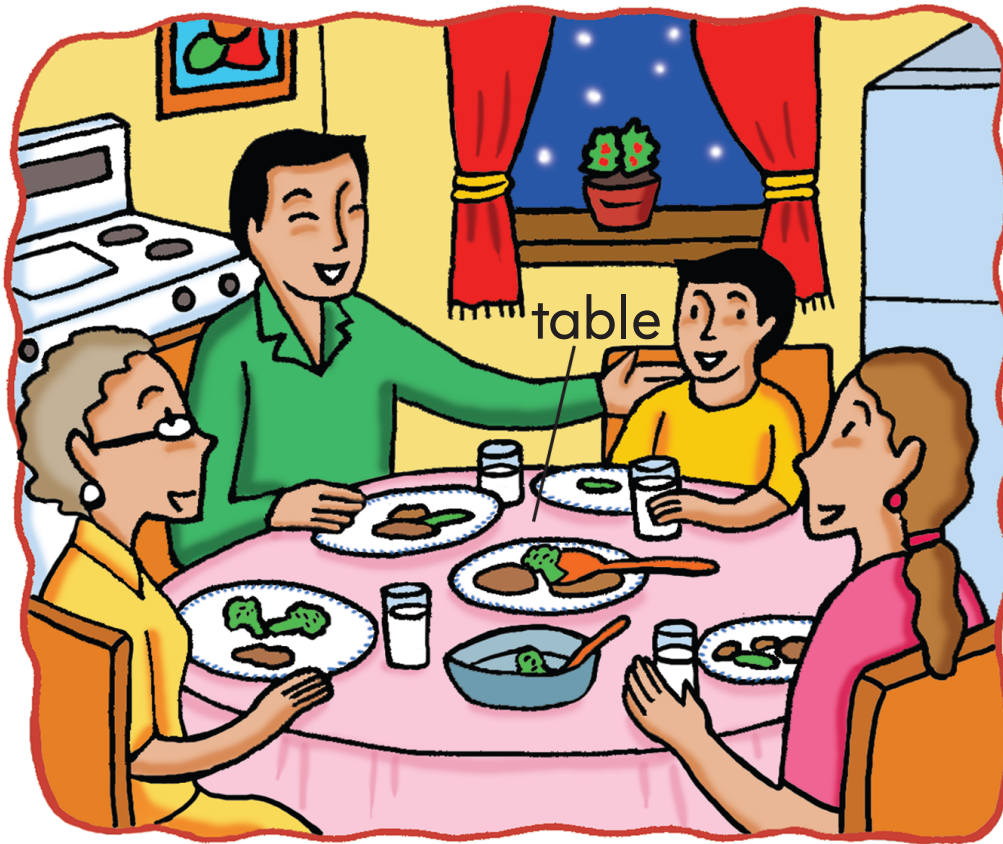
